Nestled in the heart of the Kitzbühel Alps, the Wildkogel-Arena is perfect for families, skiers, tobogganers, snowboarders, winter hikers, and sun-seekers alike. Located at 2,100 meters above sea level, this ski area is easily accessed using the Wildkogelbahn in Neukirchen or the Smaragdbahn in Bramberg.

With over 75 kilometers of snowy pistes for all abilities, the "friendliest winter sports area in Austria" has something for everyone, from beginner to expert. State-of-the-art snowmaking systems ensure optimal snow conditions all the way until Easter. And while you are enjoying the slopes, breathtaking views of the Hohe Tauern's three-thousand-meter peaks add to the glorious experience.

Fans of tobogganing discover a unique opportunity here in the Wildkogel Arena: from high on the Wildkogel, the world's longest floodlit toboggan run winds an amazing 14 kilometers spanning 1,300 vertical meters all the way down to Bramberg. Open daily (except Mondays) and lit up until 10.00 pm.

# THE LONGEST ILLUMINATED TOBOGGAN RUN IN THE WORLD



## WILD ABOUT SLEDDING!

Starting at 2,100 meters, the longest illuminated toboggan run in the world winds its way for 14 kilometers from the Smaragdbahn mountain station to Bramberg, dropping 1,300 vertical meters in 30 to 50 minutes. The top station of the Wildkogelbahn is also just a 10-minute walk from the start of the toboggan run. Sleds can be rented from sports shops in Bramberg and Neukirchen, while a free ski shuttle bus (operating until 5.15 pm) will bring you back to where you began. Public transportation and paid taxis are available later.

## CONVENIENT RETURN SERVICE:

At the end of the toboggan run, you can simply lock up your sled and slide the key into a drop box. The rental providers will collect it from there.

## OPENING TIMES OF THE TOBOGGAN RUN:

The actual hours of operation depend on snow and weather conditions. The last lift up is at 4.15 pm, with the toboggan run open daily and lit until 10.00 pm (Mondays until 6.00 pm). For safety reasons, the run is closed to all after-hours activity after these times!

## EXTENDED LIFT HOURS FOR TOBOGGANERS (UNTIL 6.30 PM):

Every Friday with the Smaragdbahn Bramberg (weather permitting). Evening rides for tobogganers not included in the ski passes.

## NEW FROM 2024/2025:

To further enhance your tobogganing experience, every Monday after 6.00 pm we conduct extensive grooming activities on the slopes.

## RULES OF TOBOGGANING

1. Be considerate of others
2. Use quality equipment – helmets (mandatory for children and teens), goggles, gloves, and sturdy boots (no ski boots)
3. Ride at a safe speed and keep a safe distance
4. Use the fringes of the slopes for climbing or descending the mountain
5. Do not obstruct the sledding lanes
6. Do not sled under influence of alcohol/drugs
7. Provide first aid when needed
8. Comply with signs, warnings, and closures
9. Do not sled on the ski slopes
10. Do not sled headfirst
11. No dogs allowed! Please leave your four-legged pal at home during this adventure!

## TOBOGGANING TIPS

- The toboggan run is **completely closed and the lights go out at 10.00 pm (6.00 pm on Mondays)**.
- Uneven areas and bumps may be encountered.
- Children under 6 should ride with parents!
- For emergencies, every second lighting pole has the phone number for mountain rescue (140) and a location ID. Secure the accident site and alert approaching sledgers. Mountain rescue fees apply as per the fee schedule.

## THE A5 RUN FOR TOTAL SLEDDING ENJOYMENT

Tobogganing enjoyment until after Easter is guaranteed by the A5 run located in the Wildkogel ski area, which opens when the world's longest floodlit sled run closes in spring. The 3.2 km-long A5 begins at the top station of the Smaragdbahn lifts and ends at the base station of the Ganzer X-press.

## FIS RULES OF THE PISTE FOR SKIERS AND SNOWBOARDERS

1. Respect other winter sports enthusiasts
2. Control your speed and manner of skiing or boarding
3. Choose a safe route for your skill level
4. Always keep sufficient distance when passing
5. Exercise caution on pistes when entering, starting, and going uphill
6. Stop only at the edge of the piste or where you are clearly visible
7. Use the edge of the piste for an ascent/descent
8. Comply with signs and signals
9. Render assistance when necessary
10. Present ID in the event of an accident

The Speedcheck measures your speed – who's the fastest? Will the record be broken?

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

## SKI PASS SYSTEM

Our SKIDATA ski pass system monitors all passengers riding the gondolas and ski lifts inside the Wildkogel-Arena. We trust our guests, of course, but pass misuse will incur a special penalty (double the rate of a regular day pass, and confiscation of the ski pass).

## CHIP CARDS

For ski passes valid for 4 days or longer, we issue chip cards for touchless access, with a € 2 deposit refunded upon return of the undamaged card. 1- to 3-day passes for the Wildkogel-Arena are issued as key tickets, functioning like chip cards but with no deposit required.

## SKI PASS ADVANCE PURCHASE / ONLINE

No need to wait in line, hit the slopes right away! Tickets are available from our pre-sale partners, hotel receptions, or online at [www.starjack.at](http://www.starjack.at) and [bergbahnen-wildkogel.skiperformance.com](http://bergbahnen-wildkogel.skiperformance.com)

## TICKET EXCHANGE, REPLACEMENT

Subsequent exchanges, transfers to third parties, extensions, or rescheduling of ski passes are not permitted. Ski passes are non-transferable.

## REFUNDS FOR SKI PASSES

Refunds are granted only in the case of accidents or illness, not for partial or full closure of lifts, gondolas, or pistes. Medical attestations and ski passes must be presented at the ticket office without delay. Refunds are calculated from the date the ski pass is returned (before 10.00 am guarantees a full refund for that day). No refunds or extensions are granted due to weather, avalanche risk, unplanned departure, service interruptions, or partial/complete closures of pistes or facilities, whether ordered by authorities or otherwise. Lost ski passes cannot be replaced.

Please note that rescue fees will apply (€ 140, or € 250 after 4.30 pm). Helicopter rescue fees are billed separately. Our piste and rescue service only monitors pistes that are marked and currently open to the public – use of off-piste terrain is at your own risk.

## FREE WI-FI

Available at the base and summit lift stations, the summit restaurant, all lifts, and the tourist offices in Neukirchen and Bramberg.

## FREE PARKING / EV CHARGING STATIONS

Plenty of free parking is available at the base stations of the Wildkogelbahn lifts in Neukirchen and the Smaragdbahn lifts in Bramberg.

**Parking Garages:** Next to the Wildkogelbahn base station in Neukirchen (P3), the "Wildkogelbahn Garage" at "Das Neukirchen Resort", and at the Smaragdbahn base station in Bramberg – parking fees apply in all cases.

**EV Charging Stations:** Available in the parking garage next to the Wildkogelbahn base station in Neukirchen (P3), "Wildkogelbahn Garage" Neukirchen, the parking area by the Smaragdbahn in Bramberg, and the Smaragdbahn parking garage – fees will apply.

**Buses:** Designated bus terminals are available.

## FREE SKI BUS SERVICE FOR SKIERS & TOBOGGANERS

Give your car a break, too! A ski bus network in Neukirchen and Bramberg, along with a ski shuttle between Uttendorf and Königsleiten in the Zillertal Arena, guarantee fast arrival and departure for skiers and sledgers. A timetable provides details on ski bus routes and stops. Additionally, the free eLINER shuttles you conveniently from the end of the valley run in Neukirchen to the Wildkogelbahn base station.
